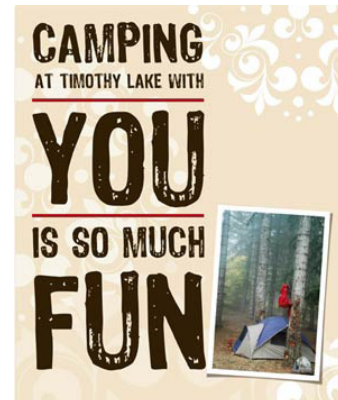
## Justified Title

Get BIG impact when you use a justified title on your scrapbook page.

## Prepare Your Title and Document

- Decide what you want to say in your title and how many words you want on each line.
- Important words should be alone on one line so they will be larger.
- It helps to type your title in a word processing document.
- Highlight the top line of your title and press Ctrl C (Mac: Cmd C) to copy it.
- In Photoshop Elements or Photoshop, click on the Foreground Color Chip and choose the color for your type. Click OK.
- Get the Horizontal Type tool and choose your font.
- Press the Caps Lock key on your keyboard to type in all capital letters.
- Choose View > Rulers.
- Click and drag out two guides from the left ruler to show the left and right boundaries of your title. (If your version of Photoshop Elements doesn't have guides, you can eyeball it or use the Grid instead: In the Menu Bar choose View > Grid.)



## Create Your Justified Title

- With the Type tool, click on the left guide.
- Press Ctrl V (Mac: Cmd V) to paste the first line of type.
- Press and hold the Ctrl key (Mac: Cmd key) to get a transform outline.

- Click and drag from the lower, right corner handle to adjust the size of the type so it fits all the way to the right guide.

**NOTE:** In all versions of Photoshop and in most versions of Photoshop Elements, press the Shift key after you click on the corner handle and continue to hold it until you let go of the mouse. This will keep the type proportional. (In Photoshop Elements 10 DO NOT press the Shift key or your type will distort.)

- When you're satisfied with the type, let go of the mouse and confirm the type.
- Repeat these instructions with each line of type.
