

- When you're satisfied with the results, in the Layers panel click on the top type layer and Shift click on the bottom type layer to select them all.
- Press Ctrl E (Mac: Cmd E) to merge the type layers into one layer.

Punch Out A Letter

- Get the Type tool and choose a new font that is thick and a large size. I used Army Wide at 140 points.
- In the Options Bar, use the Color Box to choose a new contrasting color.
- Click once on the merged type cloud and type one letter.
- Click on the check mark in the Options Bar to confirm the type.
- Get the Move tool and move the letter into the center of your cloud.
- In the Layers panel Ctrl click (Mac: Cmd click) on the new type layer thumbnail to get a selection outline.
- In the Layers panel click and drag the type layer to the Trash.
- Press the Backspace or Delete key to cut the letter out of your cloud.
- Press Ctrl D (Mac: Cmd D) to deselect.
