Alpha Ribbon

Add a pretty ribbon to an alpha letter to spruce up your page! (For Photoshop and Photoshop Elements)

- Get the Move tool.
- In the Options Bar make sure Auto Select and Show Bounding Box are checked. (Photoshop: Show Transform Controls.)
- Add an alpha letter from a kit to a scrapbook page.
- Open the ribbon you want to use on your alpha letter (File > Open).
Two ribbons are provided for you in the folder along with this manual:
 ribbon-tie-white-DigitalScrapper.png
 ribbon-tie-red-DigitalScrapper.png
- Use the Move tool to click and drag the ribbon onto your scrapbook page above the alpha letter.
- If you need to rotate the ribbon, move your cursor outside the bounding box to get a curved double headed arrow. Click and drag to rotate.
- To resize the ribbon, click on a corner handle and drag in or out. (Photoshop: Press Shift as you click and drag from a corner handle.)
- To move the ribbon, click and drag inside the outline or use the Arrow keys.
- When you're satisfied, double click inside the outline to confirm the change.
- Add a drop shadow to the ribbon, and you're done!
