Substituted Title

Substitute some of the characters in your title to add playful interest.

Type Out a Title

- Get the Horizontal Type tool.
- In the Options Bar, choose a Font and Size.
- Click on the document, type out a title, and click the check mark in the Options Bar to commit the changes.
- In the Menu Bar, choose Layer > Simplify Layer.

Replace Some of the Characters

- Get the Lasso tool.
- In the Options Bar, click on the Add to Selection icon and Feather should be 0.
- Click and drag a selection outline around the letter(s) you plan to substitute.
- Press the Backspace key (Mac: Delete).
- Press Ctrl D (Mac: Cmd D) to Deselect.

Add Embellishments

- Open an embellishment (File > Open).
- Get the Move tool.
- In the Options Bar, uncheck Auto Select Layer and check Show Bounding Box.
- Click on the embellishment and drag it onto your document.
- Click on a corner handle of the Bounding Box and drag to resize.
- Click on the check mark to commit the changes.

- Click inside the Bounding Box and move the embellishment into an empty space.
- Press Ctrl J (Mac: Cmd J) to Duplicate the embellishment if needed.
