Quoted Title

Place your title on top of extra large quotation marks for a bold statement.

Step One: Type Your Quotation Marks

- In the Layers panel, activate the layer below the title layer by clicking on it.
- In the Options Bar, change to a font with nice quotation marks and choose a large size. I am using Times New Roman Bold at 110pts.
- Holding down the Shift key, click on the document and type out a quotation mark.
- Reposition it and commit the changes.
- In the Layers panel, lower the Opacity of the quotation mark to around 40%.

Step Two: Duplicate the Quotation Marks

- Press Ctrl J (Mac: Cmd J) to Duplicate the quotation marks.
- Press Ctrl T (Mac: Cmd T) to get the Transform options.
- In the Options Bar, enter 180 degrees for the Rotation.
- Click on the check mark to commit the changes.
