

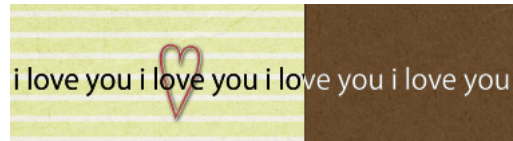
Digital Scrapper Tutorials



Two Tone Type

Create a two toned title when taking your title from light to dark areas of your scrapbook page.

Type Out Words or Phrases

- Get the Horizontal Type tool.
- In the Options Bar, choose a Font and Size.
- Click on your document and type out a word(s).
- Click on the checkmark in the Bounding Box to commit the changes.
- In the Menu Bar, choose Layer > Simplify Layer.

Split the Type

- Get the Rectangular Marquee tool.
- In the Options Bar, click on the New Selection icon and Feather should be 0.
- Click on your document and drag a selection outline around the part of the type you want to change the color of.
- Press Shift Ctrl Backspace (Mac: Shift Cmd Delete) to fill the selected text with the Background Color Chip.
- Press Ctrl D (Mac: Cmd D) to Deselect.
