



Embossed Title

Create the subtle yet stunning look of an embossed title.

Open the Word Art

- Open the word art (File > Open) that is in the Extras folder that came with this video
- Get the Move tool.
- In the Options Bar, uncheck Auto-Select Layer and check Show Bounding Box.
- Click on the word art and drag it onto your scrapbook page.



Create a Duplicate from the Background

- In the Layers panel, Ctrl click (Mac: Cmd click) on the thumbnail of the word art layer to get a selection outline.
- In the Layers panel, click on the Visibility icon of the word art layer to hide it.
- In Elements: In the Menu Bar, choose Select > Feather.
- In Photoshop: In the Menu Bar, choose Select > Modify > Feather.
- In the dialog box, enter 3px and click OK.
- In the Layers panel, activate the background layer by clicking on it.
- Press Ctrl J (Mac: Cmd J) to create a duplicate of the selected area.

Apply the Embossing Effect in Elements

- In the Menu Bar, choose Window > Effects to open the Effects panel.
- In the Effects panel, click on the Layer Styles icon and choose Bevels from the drop down menu.

- In the Effects panel, choose the Simple Sharp Inner Bevel and click Apply.
- In the Layers panel, double click directly on the Effects icon of the active layer.
- In the Styles dialog box, change the Direction of the Bevel to Down, the Size to 4px, and click OK.

Apply the Embossing Effect in Photoshop

- In the Menu Bar, choose Layer > Layer Style > Bevel and Emboss.
- In the dialog box, Style-Inner Bevel, Technique-Smooth, Direction-Down, and Size-4px. Click OK.
