Type Out Your Title

- Get the Horizontal Type tool.
- In the Options Bar, choose a block style font in a large size.
- On the document, click and type out the first letter of your title. Click the check mark to commit.
- Holding down the Shift key, click to the right of the letter you just typed and type the next letter of your title. Click the check mark to commit.
- Repeat the above command until your title is fully typed out on individual layers.

Resize Each Letter

- In Elements: In the Menu Bar, choose View > Grid.
- In Photoshop: In the Menu Bar, choose View > Show > Grid.
- In the Layers panel, activate a letter that needs resizing.
- On the document, click on a Bounding Box corner handle of a letter that needs to be resized and drag to resize.
- Click on the check mark to commit.
- Repeat with the rest of the letters making them all fit to the same size as the largest letter.
