Add the Word Art

- Open the Captured word art (File > Open) in the Extras folder that came with this video.
- Get the Move tool.
- In Elements: In the Options Bar, uncheck Auto-Select Layer and check Show Bounding Box.
- In Photoshop: In the Options Bar, uncheck Auto-Select and check Show Transform Controls.
- In the Layers panel, drag the word art layer to your scrapbook page.

Create Selection Outlines

- Get the Magic Wand tool.
- In the Options Bar: click on the Add To Selection icon, enter a Tolerance of 10, check Contiguous, and uncheck Sample All Layers.
- In the Layers panel, make sure the word art layer is active.
- On the scrapbook page, click inside all the closed areas of the word.

Fill In the Selection

- In the Layers panel, hold down the Ctrl key (Mac: Cmd key) and click on the Create a New Layer icon.
- Press the letter D to reset the Color Chips to the default of black and white.

- Press Ctrl Backspace (Mac: Cmd Delete) to fill the selection with the Background Color Chip.
- Press Ctrl D (Mac: Cmd D) to Deselect.
- In the Layers panel, lower the Opacity of the fill layer to around 60%.
