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Learning about proportions and how to use the 3 rules isn't as good as putting them into practice. In this lesson, I'm going to give you homework to help reinforce what we've learned in Section 1 of this class.

Homework Assignment Part 1 - Train Your Eagle Eye

- Go to any online gallery that hosts digital scrapbook pages.
- Look through 10-20 pages and use the 3 Simple Rules to help you study if the page contains good proportions.
- If the page doesn't, how would you use the rules to fix it?

A Note About Studying Other People's Pages:

- Please don't leave comments telling someone their page has bad proportions.
- This class is not about being perfect or having superior design choices.
- This class is about gaining confidence in the design choices we make on our own pages.
- It's okay to learn from other people's pages; we just don't tell them that.
