Learn my favorite ways to make a photo black and white in Adobe Photoshop.

Prepare the Workspace

- Open the photo (File > Open) that needs to be edited before using it on a scrapbook page.



Edit the Photo to Black and White

- In the Menu Bar, choose Filter, Camera Raw Filter.
- At the top of the Right Side Menu, click on the B&W icon to make the photo black and white.
- In the Right Side Menu, click to toggle open the Light menu.
- If needed, slide the Contrast slider to the right to add some contrast.



Edit the Photo with a Sepia Tint

- In the Layers panel, click on the Create a New Fill or Adjustment Layer icon and choose Hue/Saturation.
- In the dialog box, click to check the Colorize option.
- Click and drag the Hue slider until it's around 30.
- Click and drag the Saturation slider until it's around 10.
- Close the dialog box.
